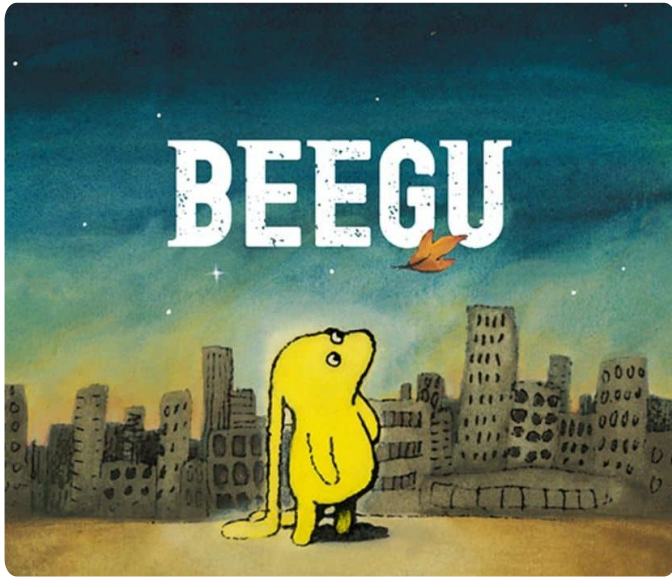
A Typical Day

In terms 1 and 2, we will also have play and learn with a gradual reduction.

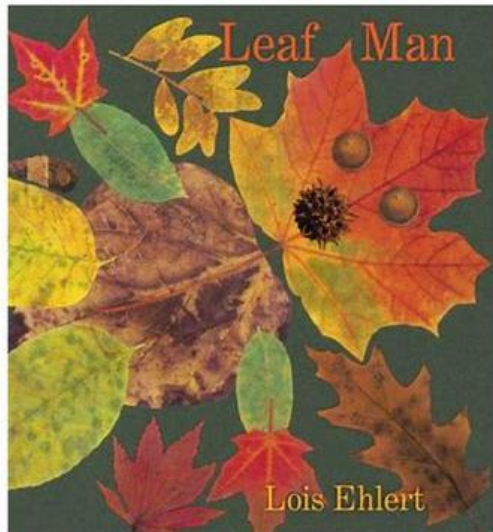
