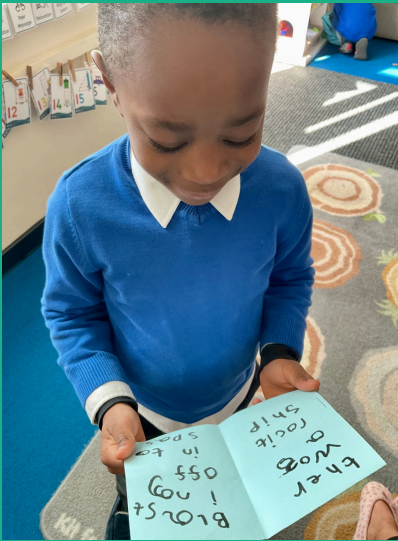
"My family tree has me at the bottom with my brother and sister. Next is my Mum and Dad and at the top is Nanny and Grandad."
