

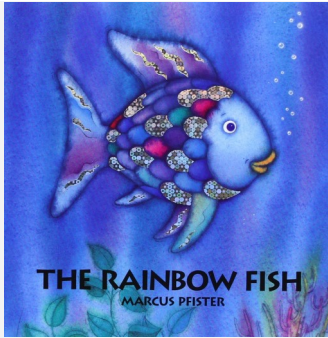

Explore, Discover, Create

Our term 6 topic title is 'Around the World in Seven Weeks'. This Geography topic will be adapted slightly this year but we will still be finding out lots about our world.

English Each day, Plum Cass will be introduced to a book which will inspire their spelling, phonics and writing. The book will give a theme to the day that will also extend vocabulary and support the development of grammar.

Mathematics Plum Class will complete the curriculum, learning about shape and space. (Home working in week one) At school we will be revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and using this to solve problems. We will recap on other areas, such as, fraction and measure.

Science We will be learning science based on the theme of the daily book. For example, we will carry out a rainbow experiment when we read the book about Elmer the very colourful elephant.

Computing We will be learning the different places work can be saved on a computer. Plum Class will learn that information is saved in bytes and that it can be stored on a computer or portable device. We will learn that computers are linked to make a network.

Geography Plum Class will find out about the hot and cold oceans in the world. We will also find out what continents are. We will also compare Hadlow village with a village in India.

Music We will be learning lots of new songs and returning to clapping rhythm and beat games.

Art Plum Class will be given lots of opportunities to make art and craft based on the theme of the day. All the work will be collected and sent home at the end of term after a short quarantine time!

PE Physical exercise will be incorporated throughout the day to keep up fitness levels.
