Essential (Supported)



These tasks are expected to be completed weekly. They are core areas of learning that underpin academic progress and success.

<p><u>Reading</u></p> 	<p>Please keep reading regularly with your child and remember to record it in your child's reading record. <p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>Set some time aside for your child to have fun whilst learning through the 1-Minute Maths app.</p> <p>This is fully aligned to the White Rose Maths scheme that the children are using in school and will consolidate and extend learning in an interactive way.</p>

<p><u>Explore</u></p> 	<p>In History this term, we will be exploring The Tudors.</p> <p>Dive into exploring The Tudors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• BBC Bitesize - Explore life for the Tudors.• Learn the Henry VIII rhyme about his wives
<p><u>Discover</u></p> 	<p>This term in Science our topic is 'Plants'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grow a plant from seed or bulb and discover what they need in order to grow.• Walk around your garden, go for a walk or look on your way to school at all the different plants, taking note of their differences and where they are growing.
